Theresa enjoys scuba diving, reading, family & world wide travel.

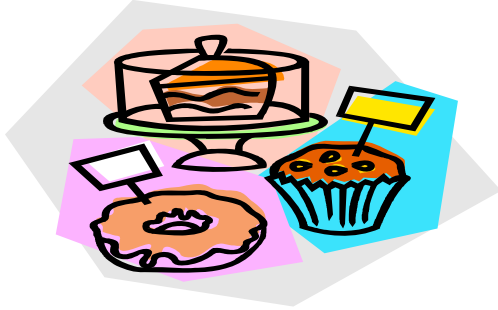

Recipe of the Month
Can't Leave Alone Bars

1pkg. White Cake Mix
2 eggs
1/3 cup oil
1 can sweetened condensed milk
1 cup(6 Oz.) semisweet chocolate chips
1/4 cup butter or margarine, cubed

In a bowl, combine cake mix, eggs & oil. With floured hands, press 2/3 of the mixture into a greased 13 x9 baking dish. Set rest a side. Combine the milk, choc. chips & butter & microwave for 45-60 seconds or until chips & butter are melted. Stir until smooth. Pour over cake mixture. Drop teaspoons of remaining cake mixture over top. Bake at 350 for 20-25 min. or until little brown. Cool before cutting. Supplied by Joanne Logan
